Eleanor Roosevelt led this effort as Chair of the Commission on Human Rights - first time in human history we have a global statement of human rights.

One of the 6 pillars, Economic and Social Council, expanded the scope beyond just the state/politics to include the broader culture.

She was an entrepreneur telling a new story and was greeted with a standing ovation in the General Assembly, still the only time that has occurred in UN history.
